2 An Act to amend and reenact § 40.1-28.10 of the Code of Virginia, relating to minimum wage.

3 [S 1] 4 Approved 5 Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia: 1. That § 40.1-28.10 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows: 6 7 § 40.1-28.10. Minimum wages. 8 A. 1. Prior to May 1, 2021, every employer shall pay to each of its employees wages at a rate not 9 less than the federal minimum wage. 10 2. Beginning May 1, 2021, every employer shall pay to each of his its employees at a rate not less than the federal minimum wage or 75 percent of the Virginia minimum wage provided for in this 11 section, whichever is greater. For the purposes of this subdivision "employee" means any person or 12 13 individual who is enrolled in an established employer on-the-job or other training program for a period 14 not to exceed 90 days which meets standards set by regulations adopted by the Commissioner. 15 B. From May 1, 2021, until January 1, 2022, every employer shall pay to each of its employees wages at a rate not less than the greater of (i) \$9.50 per hour or (ii) the federal minimum wage. 16 C. From January 1, 2022, until January 1, 2023, every employer shall pay to each of its employees 17 18 wages at a rate not less than the greater of (i) \$11.00 per hour or (ii) the federal minimum wage. D. From January 1, 2023, until January 1, 2025, every employer shall pay to each of its employees 19 20 wages at a rate not less than the greater of (i) \$12.00 per hour or (ii) the federal minimum wage. E. From January 1, 2025, until January 1, 2026, every employer shall pay to each of its employees 21 22 wages at a rate not less than the greater of (i) \$13.50 per hour or (ii) the federal minimum wage. 23 F. From January 1, 2026, until January 1, 2027, every employer shall pay to each of its employees wages at a rate not less than the greater of (i) \$15.00 per hour or (ii) the federal minimum wage. 24 G. From and after January 1, 2027, every employer shall pay to each of his its employees wages at a 25 26 rate not less than the greater of (i) the adjusted state hourly minimum wage or (ii) the federal minimum 27 wage. 28 F. H. By October 1, 2026, and annually thereafter, the Commissioner shall establish the adjusted 29 state hourly minimum wage that shall be in effect during the 12-month period commencing on the 30 following January 1. The Commissioner shall set the adjusted state hourly minimum wage at the sum of 31 (i) the amount of the state hourly minimum wage rate that is in effect on the date such adjustment is 32 made and (ii) a percentage of the amount described in clause (i) that is equal to the percentage by which 33 the United States Average Consumer Price Index for all items, all urban consumers (CPI-U), as 34 published by the Bureau of Labor Statistics of the U.S. Department of Labor, or a successor index as 35 calculated by the U.S. Department of Labor, has increased during the most recent calendar year for 36 which such information is available. The amount of each annual adjustment shall not be less than zero. 37 2. That the provisions of this act shall satisfy the reenactment requirement of Chapters 1204 and 1242 of the Acts of Assembly of 2020. 38

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
