6	A BILL to direct the Joint Commission on Technology and Science to examine the use of blockchain and
7	cryptocurrency in the Commonwealth and the creation of a Blockchain and Cryptocurrency
8	Commission.
9	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
10	<b>1.</b> § 1. That the Joint Commission on Technology and Science (JCOTS) shall, in consultation with the
11	State Corporation Commission and other relevant stakeholders, conduct an analysis of the expansion of
12	blockchain technology and cryptocurrency in the Commonwealth and the creation of a Blockchain and
13	Cryptocurrency Commission. The analysis shall include (i) an examination of the risks, including privacy
14	risks, and benefits of using blockchain technology in state and local government and in businesses in the
15	Commonwealth; and (ii) an assessment of the impact of the cryptocurrency industry on the
16	Commonwealth, including the effect on state revenues and energy consumption. The analysis shall also
17	include an assessment of creating a Blockchain and Cryptocurrency Commission to develop
18	recommendations related to the use of and regulation over blockchain technology and cryptocurrency in
19	the Commonwealth and study any other related topic that the Commission may choose to examine in
20	relation to blockchain or cryptocurrency. JCOTS shall submit a report of its findings and
21	recommendations to the Chairmen of the House Committees on Appropriations and Communications,
22	Technology and Innovation and the Senate Committees on Finance and Appropriations and General
23	Laws and Technology no later than December 1, 2024.
