11	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
12	1. That the Code of Virginia is amended by adding in Article 1 of Chapter 13 of Title 10.1 a

14	§ 10.1-1322.6. Certain natural gas pipeline expansion unlawful.
15	A. It is unlawful to increase or expand any natural gas pipeline capacity in Planning District 19,
16	whether in new or existing pipelines, that uses existing compressors powered by natural gas-fired
17	combustion turbines, diesel motors, or other technology using fossil fuels.
18	B. The provisions of this section shall apply to all proposed or existing compressors associated with

regardless of size for the purpose of air pollution reduction.

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
