6	A BILL to amend and reenact § 64.2-732 of the Code of Virginia, relating to modification or
7	termination of uneconomic trust; notice.
8	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
9	1. That § 64.2-732 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:
10	§ 64.2-732. Modification or termination of uneconomic trust.
11	A. After notice to the qualified beneficiaries, the trustee of a trust consisting of trust property having
12	a total value less than \$100,000 may terminate the trust without court approval if the trustee concludes
13	that the value of the trust property is insufficient to justify the cost of administration. <i>Notice required by</i>
14	this section shall be sent in accordance with § 64.2-707.
15	B. The court may modify or terminate a trust or remove the trustee and appoint a different trustee if
16	it determines that the value of the trust property is insufficient to justify the cost of administration.
17	C. Upon termination of a trust under this section, the trustee shall distribute the trust property in a
18	manner consistent with the purposes of the trust and may simultaneously utilize the provisions of
19	§ 64.2-779.
