3. Committee: Transportation

4. Title: Disabled parking placards; validity; fees.

5. Summary: Extends from six months to 12 months the maximum duration for which the Department of Motor Vehicles may issue a temporary removable windshield placard to a person with a disability that limits or impairs his ability to walk or that creates a concern for his safety while walking. The bill also eliminates the fee for the issuance of temporary and permanent disabled parking placards and includes technical amendments.

7. Fiscal Impact Estimates: Preliminary. See Item 8.

8. Fiscal Implications: The existing statute permits the Department of Motor Vehicles' (DMV) Commissioner to impose a reasonable fee for temporary and permanent placards, which is currently set at \$5. DMV issues an average of 180,000 temporary and permanent placards each year, collecting about \$900,000 in fees annually. The revenue loss has been assumed in the agency's ongoing operating budget. The loss will decline as the number of placards issued decreases to reflect the extension of the validity of some temporary placards from 6 months to up to 12 months.
