**3. Committee:** Public Safety

**4. Title:** Carrying a firearm or explosive material within Capitol Square and the surrounding area.

**5. Summary:** Adds an exception for off-duty law-enforcement officers to the prohibition of carrying a firearm within any building owned or leased by the Commonwealth or any agency thereof or any office where employees of the Commonwealth or any agency thereof are regularly present for the purpose of performing their official duties.

**6. Budget Amendment Necessary:** No

**7. Fiscal Impact Estimates:** None

**8. Fiscal Implications:** No state fiscal impact expected.

**9. Specific Agency or Political Subdivisions Affected:** This bill impacts the Department of General Services (DGS), agencies in any owned and leased property throughout the Commonwealth, including Capitol Square and surrounding areas, and office areas where Commonwealth employees regularly occupy for purposes of performing their official duties. Currently, there are over 10,000 agency owned facilities and over 2,000 agency leases across the Commonwealth.
