5.	<b>Summary:</b> Prohibits certain medical care facilities, certain health care professionals, and emergency medical services agencies from reporting any portion of a medical debt, defined in the bill, to a consumer reporting agency. The bill requires such facilities, professionals, and agencies to include a provision in any contract entered into with a collection entity, defined in the bill, for the purchase or collection of medical debt that prohibits the reporting of any portion of such medical debt to a consumer reporting agency. The bill provides that any portion of a medical debt reported to a consumer reporting agency in violation of such prohibition or requirement is void.
