2. Patron: Krizek
3. Committee: Passed both Houses.
4. Title: Manufactured Home Lot Rental Act; manufactured home park; notice of sale and relocation expenses.
5. Summary: Requires manufactured home park owners in Planning District 8 to provide notice to the Department of Housing and Community Development (DHCD) and the locality when such owner accepts an offer to purchase from certain third parties. Requires such notice to include notification of the locality's right to purchase the manufactured home park. The bill provides notice requirements for residents of such park and allows for opportunity to purchase for residents in Planning District 8.
6. Budget Amendment Necessary: No.
7. Fiscal Impact Estimates: Final. See item 8.
8. Fiscal Implications: The Department of Housing and Community Development has no oversight or administrative obligations regarding the Manufactured Home Lot Rental Act. The department does update and publish on its website the Landlord Tenant Handbook. Any legislative changes made to the Act will be updated, but the department can do so, along with other requirements in this bill, using current resources.

Budget amendments approved by the House and included in the Conference Report include $\$ 5$ million from unobligated balances in the agency's Low-Income Energy Efficiency Program Fund for the Department of Housing and Community Development to launch a new program to assist residents of a manufacturing home park or organizations exempt from taxation under 501(c)3 of the Internal Revenue Code acquire manufactured home parks located in Virginia.
