2. Patron: Orrock

3. Committee: Passed both Houses.

4. Title: Water facilities; staffing; of licensed operators.

5. Summary: Requires sewage treatment works, classified waterworks, and classified water treatment facilities to employ a licensed operator. The bill establishes protocol for an unexpected vacancy of the licensed operator position. The bill also permits remote monitoring of the facility by the licensed operator upon a demonstration of adequate monitoring technology.

6. Budget Amendment Necessary: No.

7. Fiscal Impact Estimates: Minimal.

8. Fiscal Implications: This legislation would have a minimal fiscal impact on the Department of Health and the Department of Environmental Quality. Any increase in workload to receive reports can be handled within existing resources.
