3. Committee: Passed Both Houses

4. Title: Department of Behavioral Health and Developmental Services; State Rental Assistance Program.

5. Summary: Directs the Commissioner of Behavioral Health and Developmental Services to work with stakeholders to develop a plan to ensure that people with disabilities across the Commonwealth, including individuals affected by the Settlement Agreement entered into on August 23, 2012 pursuant to U.S. of America v. Commonwealth of Virginia, have an opportunity to access affordable and inclusive housing, as defined in the bill. The bill requires the Commissioner to present the plan to the Chairmen of the House Committee on Health and Human Services and the Senate Committee on Education and Health by January 1, 2025.
