3. Committee: Passed Both Houses

4. Title: Department of Professional and Occupational Regulation; quorum and signature requirements.

5. Summary: Adjusts the quorum requirements for the Board for Architects, Professional Engineers, Land Surveyors, Certified Interior Designers and Landscape Architects (the Board). The bill lowers the quorum requirement of two engineers, two architects, and two land surveyors to at least one engineer, one architect, and one land surveyor. Additionally, the bill removes the requirement that licenses issued by the Board be signed by at least four members of the Board. The provisions of the act would expire on July 1, 2026.
