8.	Fiscal Implications: This bill would require the Department of Education to make Child Care Subsidy Program (CCSP) payments to providers based on enrollment. If DOE is making payments for children who are absent, for which payments are not currently made, it could result in less funding available to serve additional children. Any actual impact is indeterminate and would have to be absorbed into the existing appropriation for CCSP.
