4. Title: Decreasing probation period; criteria for mandatory reduction.

5. Summary: The substitute bill requires the Department of Corrections to meet with all relevant stakeholders, including the Virginia Probation and Parole Association and criminal justice reform organizations, and to provide a report to the General Assembly that describes in detail (i) current practices for community supervision as it relates to monitoring engagement and attainment in education, employment, treatment, and other programs and making recommendations to the court for modification of time served on probation and (ii) how such practices compare to the processes and practices that would be established pursuant to Senate Bill No. 80, 2024 Session, as reported by the Senate Committee on Rehabilitation and Social Services. The report is due no later than November 1, 2024.
