**4. Title:** Investigation prior to release; input from the attorney for the Commonwealth.

**5. Summary:** This bill requires that when the Parole Board (the Board) is conducting the required investigation to determine if a prisoner will be released on parole, the Board must notify the attorney for the Commonwealth in each jurisdiction in which an offense occurred for which the prisoner is incarcerated, and that the attorney for the Commonwealth may submit input to the Board regarding the impact the release of the prisoner will have on public safety. The bill requires that once input has been received from an attorney for the Commonwealth, the input must remain in the prisoner's parole file and must be considered by the Board at every parole review. The bill clarifies that such input does not infringe on the Board's decision-making authority.

**8. Fiscal Implications:** According to the Parole Board, this bill is not expected to have a fiscal impact on agency operations. Because the bill permits, but does not require, the attorney for the Commonwealth to provide input on the case, this bill is not expected to have a fiscal impact on Commonwealth Attorneys.
