**4. Title:** Board for Contractors; required regulations and disclosures.

**5. Summary:** Requires the Board for Contractors to adopt regulations requiring (i) all Class A, B, and C residential contractors to use legible written contracts and (ii) that in transactions involving door-to-door solicitations a statement of protections be provided by the contractor to the homeowner, consumer, or buyer. Under current law, the Board is authorized but not required to promulgate such regulations. The bill also requires the Board to promulgate regulations for specific disclosures in transactions involving certain solar facilities.
