2. Patron: Mundon King

3. Committee: Passed in both Houses.

4. Title: Home-based firearms dealers; prohibited near schools; penalties.

5. Summary: This bill provides that no home-based firearms dealer, as defined in the bill, shall be engaged in the business of selling, trading, or transferring firearms at wholesale or retail within 1.5 miles of any elementary or middle school, including buildings and grounds.

8. Fiscal Implications: The Department of State Police, which oversees the Firearms Transaction Program, does not anticipate a fiscal impact as a result of this legislation. The impact on other state agencies cannot be determined at this time.
