- **3.** Committee: Passed both Houses.
- 4. Title: Funeral arrangements; definition of next of kin; proof of designated person.
- **5. Summary:** Clarifies that, for the purpose of the definition of "next of kin," the guardian of any minor child is equal in order to a child age 18 or older. The bill also extends from 48 hours to 48 business hours the time period in which a person may provide documented proof that he is the designated person to make funeral arrangements for a decedent and clarifies that producing a copy of such decedent's will is sufficient documentation. The bill also allows funeral service licensees to require that a person claiming priority next of kin status execute a document affirming such status.
