3. Committee: Communications, Technology and Innovation

4. Title: State agencies; electronic information breach

5. Summary: Requires every state agency to promptly notify affected citizens of the Commonwealth in the event of a breach of such state agency's electronic information system from unauthorized uses, intrusions, or other security threats, which breach compromises such citizens' personal information. The bill requires the Chief Information Officer to provide requirements for such notifications.

8. Fiscal Implications: The fiscal impact of this bill is indeterminate. This bill expands the scope of what is considered a breach of a state agency's electronic system to a more broad set of criteria. The expansion of notification requirements would likely increase staff time across all state agencies in order to comply with this legislation. The need for additional resources to comply with this legislation will vary across state agency, but it can be expected that this will require additional funding.
