3. Committee: Education and Health

4. Title: Public schools; fire drills, timing and frequency.

5. Summary: Requires that, notwithstanding the Statewide Fire Prevention Code, every public school shall hold fire drills at least twice during the first 20 days of each school session and at least two additional times during the remainder of the school session. The bill also requires that the Board of Housing and Community Development and the Virginia Fire Services Board shall update the Statewide Fire Prevention Code in accordance with this act during the next update cycle.
