**3. Committee:** General Laws

**4. Title:** Virginia Public Procurement Act; prohibition on boycotting Israel.

**5. Summary:** Requires all public bodies to include in every contract in excess of \$100,000 with a business that employs more than 10 employees and in every subcontract or purchase order in excess of \$10,000 a provision that states that during the performance of the contract, neither the contracting business nor any of its affiliates shall engage in a boycott of Israel.

**8. Fiscal Implications:** None

**9. Specific Agency or Political Subdivisions Affected:** This bill as written applies to all public bodies subject to the Virginia Public Procurement Act (VPPA). This bill does not apply to higher education institutions operating under Management Agreements and Memoranda of Understanding in the operational area of procurement (currently thirteen Level III and Level II institutions). Additionally, the bill will not apply to local governments that have exempted themselves from the VPPA as authorized by V. Code §2.2-4343 (9, 10, 11).
