3. Committee: Agriculture, Chesapeake, and Natural Resources

4. Title: Food inspections; private homes; pickles and acidified vegetables; gross sales.

5. Summary: Removes the \$3,000 gross sales annual revenue cap for sales of pickles and other acidified vegetables that have an equilibrium pH value of 4.6 or lower and are processed and prepared in a private home without an inspection as otherwise required to operate a food establishment.

8. Fiscal Implications: The Virginia Department of Agriculture and Consumer Services anticipates a negligible reduction in revenue from an anticipated 20 fewer annual inspections. The Virginia Department of Health does not anticipate any impact from this legislation.
