- **4.** Title: Food inspections; private homes; pickles and acidified vegetables; gross sales.
- **5. Summary:** Raises from \$3,000 to \$9,000 the gross sales annual revenue cap for sales of pickles and other acidified vegetables that are labeled and sold for individual consumption at a private event, have an equilibrium pH value of 4.6 or lower and are processed and prepared in a private home without an inspection as otherwise required to operate a food establishment.
