**3. Committee:** Passed both houses

**4. Title:** Food inspections; private homes; pickles and acidified vegetables; gross sales.

**5. Summary:** Raises from \$3,000 to \$9,000 the gross sales annual revenue cap for sales of pickles and other acidified vegetables that are labeled and sold for individual consumption at a private event, have an equilibrium pH value of 4.6 or lower and are processed and prepared in a private home without an inspection as otherwise required to operate a food establishment.

**8. Fiscal Implications:** The Virginia Department of Agriculture and Consumer Services anticipates a negligible reduction in revenue from an anticipated 20 fewer annual inspections. The Virginia Department of Health does not anticipate any impact from this legislation.
