**3. Committee:** Passed in both Houses.

**4. Title:** Substantial Risk Order Reporting System established.

**5. Summary:** This bill requires the Department of State Police to establish a Substantial Risk Order Reporting System for the purpose of tracking and reporting substantial risk orders by locality and to publish such reports on a quarterly basis and distribute them in an electronic format to the General Assembly and the Office of the Governor. The bill provides that the Department shall remove the names and other personal identifying information from the data before the reports are published.

**7. Fiscal Impact Estimates:** Final, see Item 8 below.

**8. Fiscal Implications:** This proposal is expected to impact the Department of State Police (VSP). To meet the information and reporting requirements, VSP anticipates developing an electronic query and report to extract the data from the Virginia Criminal Information Network (VCIN). The estimated one-time general fund cost for the IT development is \$96,300.
