5.	• Summary: If the tenant gave notice to the landlord during the tenancy that the dwelling unit was in violation of certain applicable building code requirements, the landlord shall be liable to the tenant for actual damages and reasonable attorney fees. In such cases, requires the landlord to return prepaid rent, security deposit, or rent paid subsequent to the unit being condemned. The provisions of the bill do not apply if the dwelling unit was condemned through deliberate or negligent act of omission of an occupant, or if the lease was properly terminated.
