4. Title: Alcoholic beverage control; farm winery licenses; requirements and privileges.

5. Summary: This bill provides that any person who holds a farm winery license that was granted by the Board of Directors of the Virginia Alcoholic Beverage Control Authority (the Board) on or before July 1, 2020, and has continuously remained valid and active subsequent to its issuance shall, upon request by the licensee, (a) be exempt from the requirements in §§ 4.1-219 (sets limitations on Class I, II, III, and IV farm wineries) and 4.1-231.1 (sets fees on state licenses, new provisions become effective on July 1, 2024) of the Code of Virginia and (b) remain subject to the requirements of §§ 4.1-219 and 4.1-231.1 of the Code of Virginia as those sections were in effect on June 30, 2023.
