- **8. Fiscal Implications:** The Department of Emergency Management (VDEM) estimates that to develop and oversee the Program and the Fund as required by this bill, it would need additional resources to hire up to two full-time Public Safety Communications Coordinators at an annual cost of \$116,193 each (including benefits), should the program be funded to issue grants.

According to the Virginia Resources Authority (VRA), their costs to financially manage the fund would depend on the volume of activity but are preliminary estimated at \$25,000 per year. VRA notes that this bill does not expressly allow the Authority to reimburse itself for its reasonable costs and expenses incurred in the administration and management of the Fund. It is assumed that the bill is intended to allow VRA to be reimbursed for such costs from amounts in the Virginia Public Safety Communications Infrastructure Fund.
