3. Committee: Passed both Houses.

4. Title: Board of Veterinary Medicine; powers and duties; veterinary satellite offices.

5. Summary: Requires the Board of Veterinary Medicine to regulate, inspect, and register all satellite offices where veterinary medicine is practiced. The bill directs the Board to adopt emergency regulations within 280 days to implement the provisions of the bill.

6. Budget Amendment Necessary: No.

7. Fiscal Impact Estimates: Minimal.

8. Fiscal Implications: The provisions of this legislation would a minimal fiscal impact on the Board of Veterinary Medicine to regulate, inspect, and register all satellite offices where veterinary medicine is practiced. The estimated workload is expected to be handled within existing resources.
