3. Committee: General Laws and Technology

4. Title: Minimum qualifications for law-enforcement officers; citizenship; waiver.

5. Summary: Allows individuals who have been granted Deferred Action for Childhood Arrivals by U.S. Citizenship and Immigration Services to qualify for the positions of chief of police, police officer of a locality, deputy sheriff, jail officer, and law-enforcement officer. Current law allows only citizens of the United States to qualify for the named positions.

7. Fiscal Impact Estimates: Preliminary (see Item 8 below).

8. Fiscal Implications: According to the Department of Criminal Justice Services, the proposed bill is not expected to create a fiscal impact on agency resources. The proposed bill is not expected to have a fiscal impact on state law enforcement agencies. Any fiscal impact on local law-enforcement agencies is unknown at this time.
