**3. Committee:** Passed both houses

**4. Title:** Minimum qualifications for law-enforcement officers; citizenship; waiver.

**5. Summary:** Allows individuals who have been granted Deferred Action for Childhood Arrivals by U.S. Citizenship and Immigration Services to qualify for the positions of chief of police, police officer of a locality, deputy sheriff, jail officer, and law-enforcement officer. Current law allows only citizens of the United States to qualify for the named positions.

**8. Fiscal Implications:** According to the Department of Criminal Justice Services, the proposed bill is not expected to create a fiscal impact on agency resources.
