Creation of Virginia Correctional Enterprises Advisory Board; purposes.

¹⁸¹ There is hereby created the Virginia Correctional Enterprises Advisory Board, hereinafter referred to

183 or produced by Virginia Correctional Enterprises; (ii) review the pricing structure of products and 184 services manufactured or produced by Virginia Correctional Enterprises; (iii) evaluate the level and 185 quality of products and customer services offered by Virginia Correctional Enterprises, and make 186 recommendations on such quality and services; and (iv) advise the Director of the Department of 187 General Services on business trends, product development, contract opportunities, and other related 188 matters.

189 § 2.1-451.2. Appointment of Board; term of members; chairman; compensation; meetings; quorum.

190 The Virginia Correctional Enterprises Advisory Board shall be composed of fifteen members selected 191 as follows: (i) eight members, appointed by the Governor, two of whom shall be representatives of 192 institutions of higher education; two of whom shall be representatives of state agencies; two of whom 193 shall be representatives of the private business sector; one of whom shall be a representative of the Virginia Industries for the Blind; and one of whom shall be a representative of nonprofit sheltered workshops; (ii) two members of the Senate appointed by the Senate Committee on Privileges and 194 195 Elections; (iii) three members of the House of Delegates appointed by the Speaker of the House of 196 Delegates; (iv) the Director of the Department of General Services or his designee; and (v) the Director 197 198 of the Department of Corrections or his designee.

199 Legislative members and the Director of the Department of General Services and the Director of the 200 Department of Corrections shall serve on the Board until the expiration of their terms of office or until 201 their successors shall qualify. All other members shall serve four-year terms. Vacancies shall be filled 202 for the unexpired terms.

203 The Board shall elect its chairman and vice-chairman from among its members, except that the 204 Director of the Department of Corrections shall not be elected or otherwise appointed to serve as 205 chairman of the Board. Members of the Board shall receive no compensation for their services as 206 members of the Board, but the nongovernmental members shall receive reasonable expenses.

207 The Board shall meet at least quarterly and at the call of the chairman or the Director of the 208 Department of General Services. Eight members of the Board shall constitute a quorum. 209

§ 2.1-451.3. Cooperation with other agencies.

210 All agencies of the Commonwealth shall cooperate with the Board and, upon request, assist the 211 Board in the performance of its duties and responsibilities.

§ 2.1-451.4. Staff support.

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213 Such staff support as is necessary for the conduct of the Board's business shall be furnished by 214 Virginia Correctional Enterprises.

215 § 9-6.23. (Effective until July 1, 1995) Prohibition against service by legislators on boards and 216 commissions within the executive branch.

217 Members of the General Assembly shall be ineligible to serve on boards and commissions within the 218 executive branch which are responsible for administering programs established by the General Assembly. 219 Such prohibition shall not extend to boards and commissions engaged solely in policy studies or 220 commemorative activities. If any law directs the appointment of any member of the General Assembly 221 to a board or commission in the executive branch which is responsible for administering programs 222 established by the General Assembly, such portion of such law shall be void, and the Governor shall 223 appoint another person from the Commonwealth at large to fill such a position. The provisions of this section shall not apply, however, to members of the Board for Branch Pilots, who shall be appointed as 224 225 provided for in § 54.1-901; to members of the Board on Veterans' Affairs, who shall be appointed as 226 provided for in § 2.1-741; to members of the Council on Indians, who shall be appointed as provided 227 for in § 9-138.1; to members of the Board of Trustees of the Southwest Virginia Higher Education 228 Center, who shall be appointed as provided in § 23-231.3; to members of the Maternal and Child Health Council, who shall be appointed as provided for in § 9-318; to members of the Virginia Interagency 229 Coordinating Council who shall be appointed as provided in § 2.1-750; to members of the Advisory 230 231 Council on the Virginia Business-Education Partnership Program, who shall be appointed as provided in 232 § 9-326; or to members of the Workforce 2000 Advocacy Council, who shall be appointed as provided 233 in § 2.1-116.18; or to members of the Virginia Correctional Enterprises Advisory Board, who shall be 234 appointed as provided in § 2.1-451.2.

235 § 9-6.23. (Effective July 1, 1995) Prohibition against service by legislators on boards and 236 commissions within the executive branch.

237 Members of the General Assembly shall be ineligible to serve on boards and commissions within the 238 executive branch which are responsible for administering programs established by the General Assembly. 239 Such prohibition shall not extend to boards and commissions engaged solely in policy studies or 240 commemorative activities. If any law directs the appointment of any member of the General Assembly to a board or commission in the executive branch which is responsible for administering programs 241 established by the General Assembly, such portion of such law shall be void, and the Governor shall 242 243 appoint another person from the Commonwealth at large to fill such a position. - **374** § 53.1-10. Powers and duties of Director.
- The Director shall be the chief executive officer of the Department and shall have the following duties and powers:
- 1. To supervise and manage the Department and its system of state correctional facilities;
- 378 2. To implement the standards and goals of the Board as formulated for local and community379 correctional programs and facilities and lock-ups;
- 380 3. To employ such personnel and develop and implement such programs as may be necessary to carry out the provisions of this title, subject to Chapter 10 (§ 2.1-110 et seq.) of Title 2.1, and within the limits of appropriations made therefor by the General Assembly;
- 4. To make and enter into all contracts and agreements necessary or incidental to the performance of
 the Department's duties and the execution of its powers under this title, including, but not limited to,
 contracts with the United States, other states, and agencies and governmental subdivisions of this
 Commonwealth, consistent with applicable standards and goals of the Board; and
- 5. To accept, hold and enjoy gifts, donations and bequests on behalf of the Department from the
 United States government and agencies and instrumentalities thereof, and any other source, subject to the
 approval of the Governor. To these ends, the Director shall have the power to comply with such
 conditions and execute such agreements as may be necessary, convenient or desirable, consistent with
 applicable standards and goals of the Board; and

- 394 2. That the provisions of this act shall not become effective unless reenacted by a Special Session
