6	A BILL to authorize any city having a population between 100,000 and 110,000 to obtain
7	reimbursement for certain emergency law-enforcement expenses.
8	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
9	1. § 1. That the governing body of any city having a population between 100,000 and 110,000 may
10	provide by ordinance that any person who has negligently failed to provide adequate security or crowd
11	control at a sporting event, restaurant, night club or other business or commercial activity that draws
12	large crowds of people may be liable in a separate civil action for the cost associated with any
13	emergency response by the law-enforcement agency or emergency medical services personnel of such
14	city caused by the sponsor, owner or tenant of any sporting event, restaurant, night club or other
15	business or commercial establishment who negligently failed to provide adequate security or crowd
16	control. Such person shall be liable to the city in an amount not to exceed \$1,000.
