6	A BILL to amend the Code of Virginia by adding a section numbered 3.1-796.128:1, relating to
7	interference with a guide or leader dog; penalty.
8	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
9	1. That the Code of Virginia is amended by adding a section numbered 3.1-769.128:1 as follows:
10	§3.1-796.128:1. Intentional interference with a guide or leader dog.
11	A. It is unlawful for a person to, without just cause, willfully impede or interfere with the duties
12	performed by a dog if the person knows or has reason to believe the dog is a guide or leader dog. A
13	violation of this subsection is punishable as a Class 3 misdemeanor.
14	B. It is unlawful for a person to, without just cause, willfully injure a dog if the person knows or has
15	reason to believe the dog is a guide or leader dog. A violation of this subsection is punishable as a
16	Class 1 misdemeanor.
17	"Guide or leader dog" means a dog that (i) serves as a dog guide for a blind person as defined in
18	§ 63.1-142 or for a person with a visual disability, (ii) serves as a listener for a deaf or hard-of-hearing
19	person as defined in § 63.1-85.3:1 or (iii) provides support or assistance for a physically disabled or
