2 *An Act to amend and reenact § 10.1-1425.8 of the Code of Virginia, relating to used motor oil and*
3 *motor vehicle antifreeze recycling.*

6 **Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:**7 **1. That § 10.1-1425.8 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:**

8 § 10.1-1425.8. Department of Transportation; authority and duty.

9 The Department of Transportation is authorized to conduct recycling research projects, including the
10 establishment of demonstration projects which use recycled products in highway construction and
11 maintenance. Such projects may include by way of example and not by limitation the use of ground
12 rubber from used tires or glass for road surfacing, resurfacing and sub-base materials, as well as the use
13 of plastic or mixed plastic materials for ground or guard rail posts, right-of-way fence posts and sign
14 supports.

15 The Department of Transportation shall periodically review and revise its bid procedures and
16 specifications to encourage the use of products and materials with recycled content in its construction
17 and maintenance programs.

18 The Department of Transportation with the cooperation of the Department of Environmental Quality
19 shall conduct a demonstration project at one of the Department of Transportation's maintenance area
20 offices in the County of Bath, subject to such conditions as may be determined by the Commonwealth
21 Transportation Commissioner, for the collection of used motor oil and motor vehicle antifreeze from the
22 general public. The used motor oil and motor vehicle antifreeze that are collected shall be recycled or
23 otherwise disposed of in accordance with programs and plans developed by the Department of
24 Environmental Quality under § 10.1-1425.6. Funds for this project ~~will~~ shall be provided from the
25 selected county's Secondary Road construction allocations, not to exceed ~~\$20,000~~ \$5,000 annually. This
26 demonstration project ~~will~~ shall run from July 1, 1993, to ~~June 30, 1995~~ July 1, 1996. The Department
27 of Transportation, with the cooperation of the Department of Environmental Quality, shall survey the
28 counties, cities and towns of the Commonwealth to determine in which localities no commercial facility
29 for the collection of used motor oil and motor vehicle antifreeze exists. *Following such survey the*
30 *Departments of Transportation and Environmental Quality shall identify the advantages and*
31 *disadvantages of making available to the public the currently existing used oil and used motor vehicle*
32 *antifreeze collection facilities at the Department of Transportation's maintenance area offices in those*
33 *localities where no commercial collection facilities exist. The study will* shall be completed and results
34 reported to the 1995 1996 Session of the General Assembly.
