## VIRGINIA ACTS OF ASSEMBLY - CHAPTER

2 An Act to amend and reenact §§ 5.1-31 and 5.1-36 of the Code of Virginia, relating to airport 3 authorities.

### Approved

#### Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia: 6

#### 7 1. That §§ 5.1-31 and 5.1-36 of the Code of Virginia are amended and reenacted as follows:

8 § 5.1-31. Authority to acquire, construct, maintain and operate; permission of Department required. 9 All cities, incorporated towns and counties of the Commonwealth may acquire, by purchase, lease, 10 gift, condemnation or otherwise, within or without the limits of any such city, town or county, whatever land may be reasonably necessary for the purpose of establishing, constructing, owning, controlling, 11 12 leasing, equipping, improving, maintaining and operating airports for the use of airplanes; may acquire, 13 establish, construct, enlarge, improve, maintain, equip, operate and regulate the use of such airports or landing fields, structures, air navigation facilities and other property incident thereto; may make, prior to 14 15 such acquisition, investigation, surveys and plans and enter upon any lands or waters for such purposes; may construct, install, maintain and operate facilities for the servicing of aircraft, and for the 16 17 accommodation and comfort of air travelers; may purchase and sell equipment and supplies as an incident to the operation of its airport properties; provided, that in the case of any county, the exercise 18 19 of such authority beyond its territorial boundaries shall be only with the consent of the governing body 20 of the political subdivision in which the power is sought to be exercised; provided, however, that no 21 such city, town or county shall establish or operate any airport without first obtaining the permission of 22 the Board, as now or hereafter provided by law.

23 The governing body of a county, city, or town may create an airport authority that shall be 24 empowered on behalf of such county, city, or town to have and exercise the powers and rights set out in 25 this section.

26 § 5.1-36. Agreement for joint exercise of powers; governing board, etc., to act on behalf of political subdivisions; powers of board, etc. 27

28 The agreement provided for in § 5.1-35 may provide for the creation of a governing board, 29 commission, authority or body empowered to have and exercise, on behalf of the several political 30 subdivisions which are parties to such agreement, the powers, rights and authority conferred on such 31 political subdivisions by this article. Members of the governing bodies of the several political 32 subdivisions may serve as a member of a board, commission, authority or body formed pursuant to 33 § 5.1-35. Such agreement shall specify the name of the board, commission, authority or body and its composition and prescribe its powers and duties which may include powers to establish, construct, 34 manage, and operate an airport, acquire, hold and dispose of property but on behalf of the several political subdivisions, including the exercise on their behalf of the power of eminent domain. If any 35 36 such board, commission, authority or body is created, all proceedings in connection with the establishment, construction, management and operation of the airport, including application for and 37 38 39 issuance of any license required therefor, shall be in its name. The intent of § 5.1-35 and this section is 40 that any such board, commission, authority or body established by two or more political subdivisions or 41 through action of the General Assembly may have the same powers granted to a city, town and county 42 but in no case will such powers be greater than those granted to a city, town or county. Any joint 43 airport authority created pursuant to this chapter and in existence on July 1, 1994, shall be continued in lawful existence under the terms and provisions of this chapter even though all the political 44 45 subdivisions except one withdraw from the joint airport authority.
