That § 23-7.1:01 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows: § 23-7.1:01. Free tuition and required fees for certain individuals. A. Any child between the ages of sixteen and twenty-five whose parent or any person whose spouse has been killed in the line of duty while employed or serving as a law-enforcement officer, a special agent of the Department of Alcoholic Beverage Control, a state correctional, regional or local jail officer, a sheriff, a deputy sheriff, or a member of the Virginia National Guard while such member is serving in the Virginia National Guard or as a member of the Uriginia National Guard while such member is serving in the Virginia National Guard or as a member of the United States Armed Forces, shall be entitled to free undergraduate tuition and required fees at any public institution of higher education in Virginia under the following conditions: 1. The chief administrative officer of the Alcoholic Beverage Control Board, emergency medical services agency, law-enforcement agency, or other appropriate agency or the Superintendent of State Fore confighter or member of a rescue squad or in any other capacity as specified in this section and required fees at any public institution of higher education. B. Any person who is a veteran of any war, as defined by 38 C.F.R. § 3.1, and has been living in the Commonwealth for at least three years immediately prior to applying for the benefits conferred by this subsection, shall be entitled to free undergraduate tuition and required fees at any public institution of higher education in Virginia under the following conditions: 1. The Director of the Department of Veterans' Affairs provides verification of the person's service and discharge or release under conditions of as a full-time student in a public institution of higher education.
