12	and sewer authorities; and
13	WHEREAS, some concern exists that there is inadequate state overview of local regulation of water
14	and sewer service; and
15	WHEREAS, the State Corporation Commission is charged with regulating most public utilities in the
16 17	Commonwealth; and WHEPEAS it is in the best interests of the Commonwealth's citizens to provide them with adequate
17	WHEREAS, it is in the best interests of the Commonwealth's citizens to provide them with adequate and reliable water and sewer service at reasonable rates; now, therefore, be it
19	RESOLVED by the House of Delegates, the Senate concurring, that the State Corporation
20	Commission, in cooperation with the Department of Health, study the regulation of water and sewer
21	service. The Commission shall study (i) how rates, charges and fees are currently determined by water
22	and sewer authorities; (ii) whether such rates are generally reasonable; (iii) whether additional oversight
23	of such authorities is necessary; (iv) whether water quality can be improved with regulatory changes;
24	and (v) other such issues that the Commission deems appropriate. All agencies of the Commonwealth
25	shall provide assistance upon request.
26	The State Corporation Commission shall complete its work in time to submit its findings and
27 28	recommendations to the Governor and the 1996 Session of the General Assembly as provided in the
40	procedures of the Division of Legislative Automated Systems for processing legislative documents.
