7 Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:

8 1. That the Code of Virginia is amended by adding in Article 5 of Chapter 6 of Title 24.2 a 9 section numbered 24.2-686 as follows: 10

§ 24.2-686. Special elections; abolition of constitutional office by change in form of government.

The provisions of § 24.2-685 shall apply, mutatis mutandis, to any county seeking to change its form 11 of government pursuant to Chapter 13 of Title 15.1 (§ 15.1-582 et seq.) if the effect of such change in 12

form would be the abolition of an existing office created pursuant to Section 4 of Article VII of the 13

Constitution of Virginia. In such case, the circuit court may order a referendum under § 15.1-583 only if 14

requested by a voter petition meeting the requirements of § 24.2-685. In such case, a question in 15

substantially the following form shall be listed first on the ballot and be followed by those provided in 16 17 § 15.1-584:

18 "Shall the County of be authorized to change its form of government to one which would 19 eliminate the elected office(s) of ?"

20 An affirmative vote on the subsequent question or questions on the ballot shall be given effect only if

21 a majority of those voting in the referendum have voted affirmatively on the first question to authorize 22 such a change in the form of government.
