10 Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:

1. That § 29.1-521.3 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows: 11

12 § 29.1-521.3. Hunting wild birds and wild animals by disabled persons.

13 Any person, upon application to a game warden and the presentation of a medical doctor's written 14 statement based on a physical examination that such person is permanently unable to walk due to impaired mobility, may, in the discretion of the game warden, be issued a permit to shoot, from any 15 lawful location, antlerless deer throughout any firearm deer season and to shoot wild birds and wild 16 animals from a stationary automobile or other vehicle during established open hunting seasons and in 17 18 accordance with other laws and regulations. Permits issued pursuant to this section shall (i) be issued on a form provided by the Department, (ii) not authorize shooting from a stationary vehicle less than 50 19 20 feet from nor in or across any public road or highway subject to the provisions of § 29.1-526, (iii) be 21 issued for the lifetime of the permittee and be issued only to those persons who are properly licensed to 22 hunt, and (iv) be nontransferable. Any permit found in the possession of any person not entitled to such 23 permit shall be subject to confiscation by a game warden.
