CHAPTER 29

An Act to amend and reenact § 46.2-1149.1 of the Code of Virginia, relating to overweight permits for cotton module haulers.

Approved March 4, 1996

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:

1. That § 46.2-1149.1 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:

§ 46.2-1149.1. Excess weight permits for cotton module haulers.

The Commonwealth Transportation ~~Board~~ *Commissioner*, upon application made by the owner or operator of vehicles used exclusively to transport seed cotton modules, shall issue without cost a permit authorizing the operation on the highway of such vehicles, *from September 1 through December 31 of each year*, at tandem axle weights in excess of that authorized in § 46.2-1125. The Commonwealth Transportation ~~Board~~ *Commissioner* shall promulgate regulations governing such permits. Such permits shall allow the vehicles to have tandem axle weights of no more than ~~40,000~~ *44,000* pounds. No permit issued under this section shall authorize a single axle weight in excess of that authorized in § 46.2-1124 or a gross weight in excess of ~~that authorized in § 46.2-1126~~ *56,000 pounds*.
