### CHAPTER 46.

## VIRGINIA-ISRAEL ADVISORY BOARD.

§ 9-350. Virginia-Israel Advisory Board established; purpose.

The Virginia-Israel Advisory Board is hereby established and is hereafter referred to in this chapter as the "Board". The purpose of the Board shall be to advise the Governor on ways to improve economic and cultural links between the Commonwealth and the State of Israel, with a focus on the areas of commerce and trade, art and education, and general government.

§ 9-351. Membership; terms; vacancies; chairman. The Board shall consist of twenty-five members to be appointed as follows: three citizen members appointed by the Speaker of the House of Delegates; three citizen members appointed by the Senate Committee on Privileges and Elections; nineteen members who represent business, industry, education, the arts, and government, appointed by the Governor. The Secretaries of Commerce and Trade, and Education, or their designees shall serve as ex officio members of the Board.

Citizen members shall serve for terms of four years. The Secretaries of Commerce and Trade, and Education, or their designees, shall serve terms coincident with their terms of office. Vacancies occurring other than by expiration of term shall be filled for the unexpired term. Any member may be reappointed for successive terms.

The members of the Board shall elect a chairman and vice-chairman annually.

Members shall receive no compensation for their services.

§ 9-352. Powers and duties of the Board.

The Board shall:

- 1. Undertake studies and gather information and data in order to accomplish its purposes as set forth in § 9-350, and to formulate and present its recommendations to the Governor.
- 2. Apply for, accept, and expend gifts, grants, or donations from public or private sources to enable it to better carry out its purposes.
- 3. Report annually its findings and recommendations to the Governor. The Board may make interim reports to the Governor as it deems advisable.
  - § 9-353. Staff; cooperation from other state agencies.

The Office of the Governor shall serve as staff to the Board. All agencies of the Commonwealth shall assist the Board upon request.
