Possession or consumption of alcoholic beverages by interdicted persons; penalty. 12 13 No person who has been interdicted pursuant to §§ 4.1-333 and or § 4.1-334 shall possess or consume any alcoholic beverages, except those acquired in accordance with subdivisions 1 through 5 of 14 15 § 4.1-200. Internal possession shall constitute possession for the purposes of this section. Any interdicted person found in possession of alcoholic beverages in violation of this section shall be 16
