6 7	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia: 1. That § 28.2-700 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:
8	§ 28.2-700. Definitions.
9	As used in this chapter, unless the context requires a different meaning:
10 11	"Crab dredge" means a device, which may have teeth on the bar, that is designed and used to catch crabs buried in the bottom.
12	"Crab pot" means a device made of wire or thread net used to catch crabs.
13	"Peeler crab", until the Commission promulgates a different definition, means a crab that has a soft
14	shell fully developed under the hard shell, or a crab on which there is a pink or white line or rim on the
15	edge of that part of the back fin next to the outer section of this fin.
16	"Peeler pot" means a wire mesh pot baited with only live adult male (jimmy) blue crabs.
