13	1. Has been in continuous existence for at least fifty years;
14	2. Is located contiguous to Interstate Route 64;
15	3. Attracts 500,000 or more visitors annually;
16	4. Is served by AMTRAK;
17	5. Maintains a branch or subsidiary operation in a foreign country subject to the North American
18	Free Trade Agreement; and
19	6. Was commended for its activities and achievements by House Joint Resolution No. 218 of the
20	1988 Regular Session of the Virginia General Assembly.
