10	WHEREAS, non-sworn law-enforcement personnel in sheriffs' offices include dispatchers, secretaries,
11	clerks, and other support personnel; and
12	WHEREAS, such personnel play a vital role in preserving public safety in Virginia; and
13	WHEREAS, such personnel deserve to be adequately compensated for the invaluable service they
14	provide to the citizens of the Commonwealth; and
15	WHEREAS, compensation, including salaries, for such personnel is inadequate to keep pace with the
16	rising cost of living; and
17	WHEREAS, compensation, including salaries, for such personnel is well below comparable positions
18 19	in state government; and WHEREAS, such lower compensation results in high turnover and low morale among the personnel;
19 20	now, therefore, be it
20 21	RESOLVED by the House of Delegates, the Senate concurring, That the Joint Legislative Audit and
22	Review Commission be directed to study the compensation, including salaries, of non-sworn
23	law-enforcement personnel in sheriffs' offices and to compare such compensation to that of comparable
24	positions in state government. The Commission shall also examine methods to fund salary re-grades for
25	such personnel where necessary. Upon request, all agencies of the Commonwealth shall provide
26	assistance to the Commission.
27	The Commission shall complete its work in time to submit its findings and recommendations to the
28	Governor and the 1007 Session of the General Assembly as provided in the procedures of the Division

28 Governor and the 1997 Session of the General Assembly as provided in the procedures of the Division29 of Legislative Automated Systems for the processing of legislative documents.
