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11	Whereas, Wesley T. Ingram, Coy P. Goad, Jr., Sonny O. Quesinberry, Trent Goad, M. Wayne Goff,
12	Chester E. Janney, P.P.L. Therapeutics, Inc., Mike Kinzie, Junior Ray Harris, Thomas Raymond
13	Buchanan, and Charles C. Clark are, or have from time to time been, the owners of cattle in Floyd
14	County; and
15	Whereas, in April 1994, the State Veterinarian, on behalf of the Virginia Department of Agriculture
16	and Consumer Services, and the Area Veterinarian in charge, on behalf of the U.S. Department of
17	Agriculture, notified Allen Harman, C. W. Harman, Douglas Lane Belcher, and Ava B. Belcher that
18	they had reason to believe that cattle in their herds had contracted tuberculosis and needed to be
19	destroyed; and
20	Whereas, this body provided relief last year to Allen Harman, C. W. Harman, Douglas Lane Belcher,
21	and Ava B. Belcher for losses suffered in connection with having their herds destroyed in cooperation to
22	with the State Veterinarian; and
23	Whereas, Wesley T. Ingram, Coy P. Goad, Jr., Sonny O. Quesinberry, Trent Goad, M. Wayne Goff,
24	Chester E. Janney, P.P.L. Therapeutics, Inc., Mike Kinzie, Junior Ray Harris, Thomas Raymond
25	Buchanan, and Charles C. Clark have also agreed to destroy cattle for the same reasons, the belief that
26	the cattle had contracted tuberculosis, at the request of the State Veterinarian; and
27	Whereas, Wesley T. Ingram, Coy P. Goad, Jr., Sonny O. Quesinberry, Trent Goad, M. Wayne Goff,
28	Chester E. Janney, P.P.L. Therapeutics, Inc., Mike Kinzie, Junior Ray Harris, Thomas Raymond
29	Buchanan, and Charles C. Clark each had an appraisal of the condemned cattle conducted in accordance
30 31	with the provisions of § 3.1-750 of the Code of Virginia to establish the fair cash value of the destroyed
31 32	cattle; and Whereas, the U.S. Department of Agriculture paid indemnities to Wesley T. Ingram, Coy P. Goad,
32 33	Jr., Sonny O. Quesinberry, Trent Goad, M. Wayne Goff, Chester E. Janney, P.P.L. Therapeutics, Inc.,
33 34	Mike Kinzie, Junior Ray Harris, Thomas Raymond Buchanan, and Charles C. Clark, but each of these
35	indemnities was less than the fair market value of the cattle destroyed; and

38	Buchanan, and Charles C. Clark have no other means to obtain relief except by action of this body;
39	now, therefore,
<b>40</b>	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
41	1. § 1. That there is hereby appropriated from the general fund of the state treasury the sum of
42	\$1,165.00 for the relief of Wesley T. Ingram, the sum of \$878.50 for the relief of Coy P. Goad, Jr., the
43	sum of \$3,421.86 for the relief of Sonny O. Quesinberry, the sum of \$317.00 for the relief of Trent
44	Goad, the sum of \$662.00 for the relief of M. Wayne Goff, the sum of \$768.80 for the relief of Chester
45	E. Janney, the sum of \$2,026.70 for the relief of P.P.L. Therapeutics, Inc., the sum of \$321.00 for the
46	relief of Mike Kinzie, the sum of \$2, 2409.90 for the relief of Junior Ray Harris, the sum of \$357.75 for

the relief of Thomas Raymond Buchanan, and the sum of \$192.50 for the relief of Charles C. Clark, Jr. These sums shall be paid by checks issued by the State Treasurer on warrants issued by the Comptroller, upon execution by Wesley T. Ingram, Coy P. Goad, Jr., Sonny O.
