## **HOUSE BILL NO. 1919**

AMENDMENT IN THE NATURE OF A SUBSTITUTE

(Proposed by the House Committee on Appropriations

on January 31, 1997)

## (Patron Prior to Substitute—Delegate Almand)

A BILL for the relief of John N. Brophy.

Whereas, John N. Brophy's 1989 Oldsmobile was stolen in December 1995; and

8 Whereas, when the vehicle was stolen, Mr. Brophy reported the theft of the car to the Fairfax County 9 Police Department; and

10 Whereas, Mr. Brophy suffered a stroke just after the vehicle was stolen; and

11 Whereas, due to his stroke, Mr. Brophy experienced memory loss from the time the vehicle was 12 stolen in December 1995 until March 1996; and

Whereas, during the time Mr. Brophy was incapacitated and a patient at Western State Hospital, 13 between December 1995 and March 1996, the Arlington County Police Department found his vehicle 14 15 abandoned, impounded it, and sold it; and

Whereas, Fairfax County sent Mr. Brophy a personal property tax bill for the vehicle for the 1996 16 tax year: and 17

18 Whereas, Mr. Brophy has no other means to obtain relief except by action of this body; now, 19 therefore, 20

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:

21 1. § 1. That there is hereby appropriated from the general fund of the state treasury the sum of 22 \$4,850 for the relief of John H. Brophy. This sum shall be paid by check issued by the State Treasurer 23 on warrant of the Comptroller to John H. Brophy, upon execution by him of a release of all claims he 24 may have against the Commonwealth or any agency, instrumentality, officer, employee or political 25 subdivision thereof, in connection with the aforesaid occurrence.

26 \$2. That Arlington County shall reimburse the general fund of the state treasury in an amount equal 27 to the sum appropriated pursuant to this act. Such amount shall be reimbursed from the distribution of 28 net profits appropriated to Arlington County pursuant to § 4.1-117.
