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12	WHEREAS, the continued economic vitality of Northern Virginia is dependent upon an integrated
13	transportation network, including motor vehicle, rail, bus, and air travel facilities; and
14	WHEREAS, long-term highway planners in Northern Virginia have recognized the need for both
15	radial and circumferential highway facilities in order to meet the transportation and economic
16	development needs of the region; and
17	WHEREAS, long-term rail and public transit planners in Northern Virginia have only recently
18	recognized the need for both radial and circumferential rail facilities in order to efficiently serve the
19	region and the growing employment centers throughout the region; and
20	WHEREAS, various Major Investment Studies conducted in Northern Virginia have examined the
21	need for specific highway and transit improvements in the Dulles, I-66, Woodrow Wilson Bridge, and
22	I-495 corridors; and
23	WHEREAS, none of these studies has considered the need for a region-wide system of rail and
24	public transit, including both radial and circumferential rail facilities; and
25	WHEREAS, local governments, transportation commissions, the business community, and the
26	Commonwealth and its citizens are all interested in the development of a long-term, comprehensive plan
27	for rail and public transit in Northern Virginia, including both radial and circumferential rail facilities;
28	now, therefore, be it
29	RESOLVED by the House of Delegates, the Senate concurring, That the Department of Rail and
30	Public Transportation be requested to study and develop a comprehensive plan for rail and public transit
31	in Northern Virginia. The study shall, among other things, identify and develop a plan to meet the
32	long-term rail and public transit needs of the area, including both radial and circumferential rail
33	facilities.
34	All agencies of the Commonwealth shall provide assistance to the Department of Rail and Public
35	Transportation for this study, upon request.
36	The Department of Rail and Public Transportation shall complete its work in time to submit its
37	findings and recommendations to the Governor and the [1998 1999] Session of the General Assembly
38	as provided in the procedures of the Division of Legislative Automated Systems for the processing of
39	legislative documents.

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
