1 VIRGINIA ACTS OF ASSEMBLY — CHAPTER

2 *An Act to amend and reenact § 10.1-2211 of the Code of Virginia, relating to Confederate cemeteries*
3 *and graves.*

6 **Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:**

7 **1. That § 10.1-2211 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:**

8 § 10.1-2211. Disbursement of funds appropriated for caring for Confederate cemeteries and graves.

9 A. At the direction of the Director, the Comptroller of the Commonwealth is instructed and
10 empowered to draw annual warrants upon the State Treasurer from any sums that may be provided in
11 the general appropriations act, in favor of the treasurers of the Confederate memorial associations and
12 chapters of the United Daughters of the Confederacy set forth in subsection B of this section. Such sums
13 shall be expended by the associations and organizations for the routine maintenance of their respective
14 Confederate cemeteries and graves and for the graves of Confederate soldiers and sailors not otherwise
15 cared for in other cemeteries, and in erecting and caring for markers, memorials, and monuments to the
16 memory of such soldiers and sailors. All such associations and organizations, through their proper
17 officers, are required after July 1 of each year to submit to the Director a certified statement that the
18 funds appropriated to the association or organization in the preceding fiscal year were or will be
19 expended for the routine maintenance of cemeteries specified in this section and the graves of
20 Confederate soldiers and sailors and in erecting and caring for markers, memorials and monuments to
21 the memory of such soldiers and sailors. An association or organization failing to comply with any of
22 the requirements of this section shall be prohibited from receiving moneys allocated under this section
23 for all subsequent fiscal years until the association or organization fully complies with the requirements.

24 B. Allocation of appropriations made pursuant to this section shall be based on the number of graves,
25 monuments and markers as set forth opposite the association's or organization's name, or as documented
26 by each association or organization multiplied by the rate of five dollars or the average actual cost of
27 routine maintenance, whichever is greater, for each grave, monument or marker in the care of a
28 Confederate memorial association or chapter of the United Daughters of the Confederacy. For the
29 purposes of this section the "average actual cost of care" shall be determined by the Department in a
30 biennial survey of at least four properly maintained cemeteries, each located in a different geographical
31 region of the Commonwealth.

600 C. In addition to funds that may be provided pursuant to subsection B of this section, any of the
601 Confederate memorial associations and chapters of the United Daughters of the Confederacy set forth in
602 subsection B may make application to the Director for grants to perform extraordinary maintenance,
603 renovation, repair or reconstruction of any of their respective Confederate cemeteries and graves and for
604 the graves of Confederate soldiers and sailors. These grants shall be made from any appropriation made
605 available by the General Assembly for such purpose. In making such grants, the Director shall give full
606 consideration to the assistance available from the United States Department of Veterans' Veterans
607 Affairs, or other agencies, except in those instances where such assistance is deemed by the Director to
608 be detrimental to the historical, artistic or architectural significance of the site.

609 D. Local matching funds shall not be required for grants made pursuant to this section.

610 2. That the provision of this act relating to the Sons of the Confederate Veterans, Oakwood
611 Committee, shall become effective on July 1, 1998, and only if funding to implement that provision
612 in an amount consistent with the provisions of subsection B of § 10.1-2211 is provided in the
613 general appropriation act for each fiscal year of the biennium ending June 30, 2000.

614 3. That notwithstanding any other provision of this act or any provision of subsection C of
615 § 10.1-2211, the Sons of the Confederate Veterans, Oakwood Committee, shall be eligible,
616 beginning July 1, 1997, for a one time grant that is subject to the approval of the Director and not

617 to exceed \$ 30,000, for purposes consistent with those of subsection C of § 10.1-2211.
618 Notwithstanding the provisions of subsection C of § 10.1-2211 relating to the funding source for
619 grants, the grant may be made from available appropriated funds.
