- 17 § 46.2-692.1. Sample license plates; fee; use.

18 Upon application therefor, the Commissioner may issue samples of authorized license plates currently 19 issued by the Department. Sample license plates may display, as requested by the applicant and approved by the Commissioner, a combination of up to seven numbers or letters, when feasible. 20 Notwithstanding the provisions of this section, every such license plate shall display the word 21 22 "SAMPLE" on its face and shall bear month and year decals marked "SAMPLE.", in a manner 23 prescribed by the Commissioner.

24 The fee for sample license plates not displaying numbers or letters requested by the applicant shall 25 be ten dollars for each license plate. The fee for sample license plates displaying numbers or letters 26 requested by the applicant shall be twenty dollars for each license plate. Sample license plates shall not 27 be valid for registration purposes and shall not be mounted or displayed on any motor vehicle. 28

§ 46.2-698. Fees for farm vehicles.

29 A. The fees for registration of farm motor vehicles having gross weights of 7,500 pounds or more, 30 when such vehicles are used exclusively for farm use as defined in this section, shall be one-half of the 31 fee per 1,000 pounds of gross weight for private carriers as calculated under the provisions of 32 § 46.2-697 and one-half of the fee for overload permits under § 46.2-1128, but the annual registration 33 fee to be paid for each farm vehicle shall not be less than fifteen dollars. 34

B. A farm motor vehicle is used exclusively for farm use:

35 1. When owned by a person who is engaged either as an owner, renter, or operator of a farm of a size reasonably requiring the use of such vehicle or vehicles and when such vehicle is: 36

37 a. Used in the transportation of agricultural commodities, poultry, dairy products, or livestock of the 38 farm he is working to market, or to other points for sale or processing, or when used to transport 39 materials, tools, equipment, or supplies which are to be used or consumed on the farm he is working, or 40 when used for any other transportation incidental to the regular operation of such farm; or

41 b. Used in transporting forest products, including forest materials originating on a farm or incident to 42 the regular operation of a farm, to the farm he is working or transporting for any purpose forest 43 products which originate on the farm he is working; or

44 c. Used in the transportation of farm produce, supplies, equipment, or materials to a farm not worked 45 by him, pursuant to a mutual cooperative agreement.

2. When the nonfarm use of such motor vehicle is limited to the personal use of the owner and his 46 47 immediate family in attending church or school, securing medical treatment or supplies, or securing **48** other household or family necessities.

C. As used in this section, the term "farm" shall include one or more farms, orchards, or ranches, but 49 50 does not include a tree farm unless it is part of what otherwise is a farm.

51 D. The first application for registration of a vehicle under this section shall be made on forms provided by the Department and shall include: 52 53

1. The location and acreage of each farm on which the vehicle to be registered is to be used;

54 2. The type of agricultural commodities, poultry, dairy products or livestock produced on such farms 55 and the approximate amounts produced annually;

56 3. A statement, signed by the vehicle's owner, that the vehicle to be registered will only be used for

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one or more of the purposes specified in subsection B of this section; 57 58

4. Other information required by the Department; and

5. The above information is not required for the renewal of a vehicle's registration under this section.

60 E. The Department shall issue appropriately designed designated license plates for those motor 61 vehicles registered under this section. The design of manner in which such license plates are designated 62 shall be at the discretion of the Commissioner.

63 F. The owner of a farm vehicle shall inform the Commissioner within 30 days or at the time of his 64 next registration renewal, whichever comes first, when such vehicle is no longer used exclusively for 65 farm use as defined in this section, and shall pay the appropriate registration fee for the vehicle based 66 on its type of operation. It shall constitute a Class 2 misdemeanor to: (i) operate or to permit the operation of any farm motor vehicle for which the fee for registration and license plates is herein 67 prescribed on any highway in the Commonwealth without first having paid the prescribed registration 68 fee; or (ii) operate or permit the operation of any motor vehicle, registered under this section, for 69 purposes other than as provided under subsection B of this section; or (iii) operate as a for-hire vehicle. 70

G. Nothing in this section shall affect the exemptions of agricultural and horticultural vehicles under 71 72 §§ 46.2-664 through 46.2-670.

73 H. Notwithstanding other provisions of this section, vehicles licensed under this section may be used 74 by volunteer rescue squad members and volunteer firefighters in responding to emergency calls, in 75 reporting for regular duty, and in attending squad meetings and drills. 76

§ 46.2-711. Furnishing number and design of plates; displaying on vehicles required.

77 A. The Department shall furnish one license plate for every registered motorcycle, tractor truck, 78 semitrailer, or trailer, and two license plates for every other registered motor vehicle, except to licensed 79 motor vehicle dealers and persons delivering unladen vehicles who shall be furnished one license plate. 80 The license plates for trailers, semitrailers, commercial vehicles, and trucks, other than license plates for dealers, may be of such design as to prevent removal without mutilating some part of the indicia 81 82 forming a part of the license plate, when secured to the bracket. 83

B. The Department shall issue appropriately designated license plates for:

84 1. Passenger-carrying vehicles for rent or hire for the transportation of passengers for private trips; 85 2. Taxicabs;

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3. Executive sedans as defined in § 46.2-2500; 87 4. Limousines as defined in § 46.2-2500;

88 5. Passenger-carrying vehicles operated by common carriers or restricted common carriers;

89 6. Property-carrying motor vehicles to applicants who operate as private carriers only;

- 90 7. Applicants who operate motor vehicles as carriers for rent or hire; and
- 91 8. Motor vehicles held for rental as defined in § 58.1-2401; and

92 9. Trailers and semitrailers.

93 C. The Department shall issue appropriately designated license plates for motor vehicles held for 94 rental as defined in § 58.1-2401.

95 D. No vehicles shall be operated on the highways in the Commonwealth without displaying the 96 license plates required by this chapter.

97 \mathbf{D} E. Pickup or panel trucks are exempt from the provisions of subsection B of this section with 98 reference to displaying for-hire license plates when operated as a carrier for rent or hire. 99

§ 46.2-724. Operation for hire of certain vehicles registered as not-for-hire; penalty.

100 If a motor vehicle of over 10,000 pounds registered gross weight displaying license plates entitling it that is registered to be operated exclusively not-for-hire is operated for-hire, the licensee shall be guilty 101 102 of a traffic infraction. This penalty shall be in addition to the penalty prescribed by § 46.2-704. 103

§ 46.2-725. Special license plates, generally.

104 A. No series of special license plates shall be created or issued by the Commissioner or the Department except as authorized in this article. No special license plates in any series not provided for 105 in this article and no registration decal for any such license plate shall be issued, reissued, or renewed 106 on or after July 1, 1995. However, subject to the limitations contained in subdivisions 1 and 2 of 107 108 subsection B of this section, the Commissioner may issue special license plates that are combinations of 109 no more than two series of special license plates authorized in this article and currently issued by the 110 Department; the fee for any such combination shall be equal to the sum of the fees for the two series plus the fee for reserved numbers and letters, if applicable. The provisions of subdivisions 1 and 2 of 111 112 subsection B of this section shall not apply to special license plates that are combinations of two series of special license plates authorized in this article and currently issued by the Department if one of the 113 114 two combined designs, when feasible, incorporates or includes the international symbol of access. 115

B. Except as otherwise provided in this article:

1. No license plates provided for in this article shall be issued until the Commissioner receives at 116 least 350 prepaid applications therefor. In the event that 350 or more prepaid applications have not 117

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118 been received on or before the last day of the third year from the date the license plates were last
119 authorized, no such license plates shall be issued unless the license plates are reauthorized by the
120 General Assembly. Such reauthorized license plates shall remain subject to the provisions of this article;

121 2. No additional license plates shall be issued or reissued in any series that, after five or more years
122 of issuance, has fewer than 100 active sets of plates, unless applications therefor again meet the criterion
123 of subdivision 1 of this subsection; and

124 3. The annual fee for the issuance of any license plates issued pursuant to this article shall be ten 125 dollars plus the prescribed fee for state license plates. Applications for all special license plates issued 126 pursuant to this article shall be on forms prescribed by the Commissioner. All special license plates 127 issued pursuant to this article shall be of designs prescribed by the Commissioner and shall bear unique 128 letters and numerals, clearly distinguishable from any other license plate designs, and be readily 129 identifiable by law-enforcement personnel.

130 No other state license plates shall be required on any vehicles bearing special license plates issued131 under the provisions of this article.

All fees collected by the Department under this article shall be paid by the Commissioner into thestate treasury and shall be set aside as a special fund to be used to meet the expenses of theDepartment.

C. The provisions of this article relating to registration fees shall apply only to those vehicles
registered as passenger cars, motor homes, and pick-up or panel trucks, as defined in § 46.2-100. All
other vehicle types registered with special license plates shall be subject to the appropriate special
license plate fees, registration fees and other fees prescribed by law for such vehicle types.

139 § 46.2-729.1. Presidential inauguration license plates.

Notwithstanding any other provisions of law, presidential inauguration license plates duly issued by
the District of Columbia may be displayed on any motor vehicle duly registered and licensed in Virginia
in lieu of license plates assigned to that motor vehicle. Such presidential license plates shall not be
displayed except for the period beginning January 1 through the last day of March in the year of such
inauguration.

145 § 46.2-734.1. Special license plates for certain law-enforcement officers.

146 On receipt of an application and written confirmation that the applicant is a law-enforcement officer,

147 the Commissioner shall issue to the applicant special license plates.

148 § 46.2-739. Special license plates for certain disabled veterans; fees.

A. On receipt of an application, the Commissioner shall issue special license plates to applicants who
are disabled veterans as defined in § 46.2-100 or unremarried surviving spouses of such disabled
veterans. These license plates shall be special permanent red, white, and blue license plates bearing the
letters "DV." The application shall be accompanied by a certification from the U.S. Veterans
Administration that the veteran has been so designated and that his disability is service-connected.
License plates issued under this subsection shall not permit the vehicles upon which they are displayed
to use parking spaces reserved for persons with disabilities that limit or impair their ability to walk.

156 B. On receipt of an application, the Commissioner shall issue special DV disabled parking license 157 plates displaying the international symbol of access in the same size as the numbers and letters on the 158 plate and in a color that contrasts to the background to veterans who are also persons with disabilities 159 that limit or impair their ability to walk as defined in § 46.2-100. The Commissioner shall require that such application be accompanied by a certification from a licensed physician to that effect. Special DV 160 disabled parking license plates issued under this subsection shall authorize the vehicles upon which they 161 162 are displayed to use parking spaces reserved for persons with disabilities that limit or impair their ability 163 to walk.

164 No annual registration fee, as prescribed in § 46.2-694, and no annual fee, as set forth in subdivision
 165 3 of subsection B of § 46.2-725, shall be required for any one motor vehicle owned and used personally
 166 by any veteran, provided such vehicle displays license plates issued under this section.

167 The provisions of subdivisions 1 and 2 of subsection B of § 46.2-725 shall not apply to license 168 plates issued under this section.

169 § 46.2-741. Special license plates for survivors of attack on Pearl Harbor; fees.

170 On receipt of an application and written evidence that the applicant is an honorably discharged 171 former member of one of the armed forces of the United States and, while serving in the armed forces 172 of the United States, was present during the attack on the island of Oahu, Territory of Hawaii, on 173 December 7, 1941, between the hours of 7:55 a.m. and 9:45 a.m., Hawaii time, the Commissioner shall 174 issue to the applicant special license plates identifying the vehicle as registered to a Pearl Harbor 175 survivor.

176 For each set of license plates issued under this section, the Commissioner shall charge, in addition **177** to the prescribed cost of state license plates, a one-time fee of ten dollars at the time the plates are

178 issued.

179 The provisions of subdivisions 1 and 2 of subsection B of § 46.2-725 shall not apply to license 180 plates issued under this section.

§ 46.2-742.2. Special license plates for persons awarded the Navy Cross, the Distinguished Service 181 182 Cross, the Air Force Cross, or the Distinguished Flying Cross.

183 On receipt of an application and written evidence that the applicant has been awarded the Navy 184 Cross, the Distinguished Service Cross, the Air Force Cross, or the Distinguished Flying Cross, the 185 Commissioner shall issue to the applicant special license plates.

The provisions of subdivisions 1 and 2 of subsection B of § 46.2-725 shall not apply to license 186 187 plates issued under this section.

188 Unremarried surviving spouses of persons eligible to receive special license plates under this section 189 may also be issued special license plates under this section.

190 § 46.2-743. Special license plates for certain veterans.

191 A. On receipt of an application and written evidence that the applicant is an honorably discharged 192 former member of one of the armed forces of the United States, the Commissioner shall issue to the 193 applicant special license plates.

194 B. On receipt of an application and written evidence that the applicant is an active duty or retired 195 member of the United States Army, Navy, Air Force, or Marine Corps, the Commissioner shall issue to 196 the applicant special license plates whose design incorporates an emblem of the military service of 197 which the applicant is an active duty or retired member.

198 C. On receipt of an application and written evidence that the applicant is a veteran of World War II, 199 the Commissioner shall issue special license plates to veterans of World War II.

200 D. On receipt of an application and written evidence that the applicant is a veteran of the Korean 201 War, the Commissioner shall issue special license plates to veterans of the Korean War.

202 E. On receipt of an application and written evidence that the applicant is a veteran of the Vietnam 203 War, the Commissioner shall issue special license plates to veterans of the Vietnam War.

204 F. On receipt of an application and written evidence that the applicant is a veteran of Operation 205 Desert Shield or Operation Desert Storm, the Commissioner shall issue special license plates to veterans 206 of those military operations.

207 F. G. The provisions of subdivisions 1 and 2 of subsection B of § 46.2-725 shall not apply to license 208 plates issued under subsection A, C, D, or E of this section. 209

§ 46.2-746.4. Special license plates for members of certain military veterans' organizations.

210 On receipt of an application and written evidence that the applicant is a member of any of the following military veterans' organizations, the Commissioner shall issue special license plates to the 211 212 members of the following organizations: the American Legion, the Disabled American Veterans, the 213 Legion of Valor of the USA, the Marine Corps League, the First Marine Division Association, the Retired Officers Association, the Veterans of Foreign Wars, and the Vietnam Veterans of America. 214

The provisions of subdivisions 1 and 2 of subsection B of § 46.2-725 shall not apply to license plates 215 issued to members of the Legion of Valor of the USA under this section. 216

217 § 46.2-746.4:1. Special license plates for submarine service veterans.

218 On receipt of an application and written evidence that the applicant is a submarine service veteran 219 and a graduate of the U.S. Navy Submarine School, the Commissioner shall issue special license plates 220 to submarine service veterans. 221

§ 46.2-746.5. Special license plates for National Guard retirees; fees.

222 On receipt of an application and written evidence that the applicant is a retired member of the 223 National Guard, the Commissioner shall issue special license plates to National Guard retirees.

224 The fee for license plates issued under this section to retired members of the Virginia National 225 Guard shall be the fee prescribed in § 46.2-694, unless the plates bear reserved numbers or letters as 226 provided for in § 46.2-726. In this latter case, the fee for the issuance of license plates shall be the 227 same as for those issued under § 46.2-726.

228 The fee for non-Virginia National Guard retirees shall be ten dollars per year plus the prescribed 229 cost for state license plates, unless the plates bear reserved numbers or letters as provided for in 230 § 46.2-726. In this latter case, such license plates shall be subject to an additional charge of ten dollars 231 per year for the reserved numbers or letters. 232

§ 46.2-746.8. Special license plates for members of certain occupational associations.

233 On receipt of an application and written evidence that the applicant is a member of such 234 organization, the Commissioner shall issue special license plates to members of the following 235 organizations: the Communications Workers of America, the Virginia Sheriffs' Association, the Fraternal 236 Order of Police, the International Association of Firefighters, the Virginia State Firefighters Association, 237 the State Fire Chiefs Association of Virginia, the Association of Realtors, and the Society of Certified 238 Public Accountants.

239 § 46.2-746.10. Special license plates for supporters of the AFL-CIO.

- 240 On receipt of an application therefor, the Commissioner shall issue special license plates to 241 supporters of the AFL-CIO.
- § 46.2-747.1. Special license plates for members of the Gold Wing Road Riders Association. 242

243 On receipt of an application and written evidence that the applicant is a member of the Gold Wing 244 Road Riders Association, the Commissioner shall issue special license plates to members of the Gold 245 Wing Road Riders Association.

246 § 46.2-748.2. Special license plates; Virginia Scuba Diver.

247 On receipt of an application therefor, the Commissioner shall issue to the applicant special license 248 plates bearing the legend: VIRGINIA SCUBA DIVER.

- 249 § 46.2-749.2:8. Special license plates for supporters of the Virginia's Western Highlands Travel 250 Council.
- 251 On receipt of an application therefor, the Commissioner shall issue special license plates to 252 supporters of the Virginia's Western Highlands Travel Council.

253 § 46.2-749.2:9. Special license plates for supporters of the Virginia Drug Abuse Resistance 254 Education Association (D.A.R.E.), Inc.

On receipt of an application therefor, the Commissioner shall issue special license plates to 255 256 supporters of the Virginia Drug Abuse Resistance Education Association (D.A.R.E.), Inc.

257 § 46.2-749.2:10. Special license plates for supporters of community traffic safety programs in the 258 Commonwealth; fees.

259 A. On receipt of an application and payment of the fee prescribed by this section, the Commissioner 260 shall issue special license plates bearing the following legend: DRIVE SMART.

261 B. The annual fee for plates issued pursuant to this section shall be twenty-five dollars in addition to 262 the prescribed fee for state license plates. For each such twenty-five-dollar fee collected in excess of 263 1,000 registrations pursuant to this section, fifteen dollars shall be paid into the state treasury and credited to the special nonreverting fund known as the Traffic Safety Fund, established within the 264 265 Department of Accounts, for use by the Department of Motor Vehicles to support community traffic 266 safety programs in the Commonwealth.

§ 46.2-749.2:11. Special license plates for supporters of the Virginia Education Foundation.

268 On receipt of an application therefor, the Commissioner shall issue special license plates to 269 supporters of the Virginia Education Foundation.

§ 46.2-749.2:12. Special license plates for supporters of Operation Smile.

271 On receipt of an application therefor, the Commissioner shall issue special license plates to 272 supporters of Operation Smile. 273

§ 46.2-749.4:1. Special license plates for Historic Yorktown.

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274 A. On receipt of an application and payment of the fee prescribed by this section, the Commissioner 275 shall issue special license plates bearing the following legend: HISTORIC YORKTOWN.

276 B. The annual fee for plates issued pursuant to this section shall be twenty-five dollars in addition to 277 the prescribed fee for state license plates. For each such twenty-five-dollar fee collected in excess of 278 1,000 registrations pursuant to this section, fifteen dollars shall be paid into the state treasury and 279 credited to the special nonreverting fund known as the Historic Yorktown Fund, established within the Department of Accounts. These funds shall be paid annually to the Town of Yorktown and may be used 280 281 as provided by the governing body. 282

§ 46.2-749.4:2. Special license plates for Gloucester County; fees.

283 A. On receipt of an application and payment of the fee prescribed by this section, the Commissioner 284 shall issue special license plates bearing the following legend: GLOUCESTER COUNTY.

285 B. The annual fee for plates issued pursuant to this section shall be twenty-five dollars in addition to 286 the prescribed fee for state license plates. For each such twenty-five-dollar fee collected in excess of 287 1,000 registrations pursuant to this section, fifteen dollars shall be paid into the state treasury and 288 credited to the special nonreverting fund known as the Gloucester County Fund, established within the 289 Department of Accounts. These funds shall be paid annually to the County of Gloucester and may be 290 used as provided by the governing body.

291 § 46.2-749.4:3. Special license plates for supporters of parental involvement in local public school 292 programs.

293 On receipt of an application therefor, the Commissioner shall issue special license plates to 294 supporters of parental involvement in local public school programs.

295 § 46.2-749.6:1. Special license plates for supporters of the Washington D.C. United soccer team.

296 On receipt of an application therefor, the Commissioner shall issue special license plates to 297 supporters of the Washington D.C. United soccer team.

298 § 46.2-749.7:2. Special license plates; Old Dominion Boat Club.

299 On receipt of an application therefor, the Commissioner shall issue to the applicant special license 300 plates bearing the following legend: OLD DOMINION BOAT CLUB.
